Aboriginal Workers & Workers of Colour (AWOC) Conference Redefining the True Faces of Our Union June 03 to 05, 2016 - Port Elgin Family Education Centre

Unifor recognizes that building a strong union requires being an inclusive one, which is why Unifor is fully committed to the representation of equity seeking groups in the structures of the union at all levels.

Across the country, Aboriginal workers and Workers of Colour are building our union and strengthening the labour movement. Recognizing that solidarity is the key to building a unified working class, this year's conference theme is "Redefining the True Faces of Our Union" which speaks to Unifor's resolve in not letting others divide us based on our race or ethnic background.

Through a combination of exciting guest speakers, plenary, creative workshops, and cultural activities, delegates will have an opportunity to organize, strategize and build networks for moving forward our union – and our country.

Some of the issues we will be focusing on are the continued racism and discrimination against Aboriginal and workers of colour, and discuss a strategy to increase participation by the A&WofC in our union activities and leadership.

The conference is intended to compel our members to fight for equality and for political, economic and social justice, and challenge inequality and racism wherever they encounter it. It will also provide a safe space for members to share strategies and skills, and solidify confidence in enabling them to continue the fight for justice in their workplaces and in their communities.

Our union's commitment to the principles of human rights and equality can only be met with the *total participation* and involvement of our leadership and activists.

Please ensure to involve women and young A&WofC activists in your delegation.

Deadline for registrations is May 25, 2016 - Local Unions are urged to select and register delegates as soon as possible as registration will be handled on a first come – first served basis.

Accommodation and Meals

Delegates must stay at the Centre (unless we advise that the Centre is full). Rates include 2-nights' accommodation, beginning with dinner on Friday - up to and including Sunday lunch.

Double occupancy units are also equipped with a separate study which includes a fold-out 'Murphy bed' for those wishing additional privacy. Reservations are on a first come, first served basis.

Single room with partner	\$ 620.00 per couple
Single room (one person in the room)	\$ 520.00 per delegate
Children/Youth aged 17 +	\$ 100.00 per person
Children 12 - 16 years old	\$ 50.00 per child
Children 11 years & under	~ No Charge ~

Note: if family member(s) are being paid for <u>by the individual</u> and not by the local, the local pays the "single occupancy" rate and the following rates apply (includes taxes):

- Spouse or child over 16 years = \$113.00
- Child 12 to 16 years = \$ 56.50

Child Care

Free child care is available for children of eligible delegates **during conference hours only.** An eligible delegate is a single parent, a parent **not** accompanied by a spouse/companion, or where **both** parents are delegates. Delegates requiring childcare **must pre-register by May 05, 2016.** Include the attached childcare form with the registration. Last minute childcare registrations may result in disappointment if there is insufficient staff. As well, a late fee will apply.
