The Retirees' Benefit Program is designed for Union Retirees age 50 and up, who become individual members of The Congress of Union Retirees of Canada – CURC.

Application for CURC membership may be made before or in conjunction with applying for any of the 3 insurance plans.



The CURC Retiree Benefit Program provides protection for Union Retirees and their families when coverage under their group insurance plan terminates.

Retirees may apply for any one, or a combination of benefits.

Life Insurance, Accidental Death & Dismemberment and Final Expense Benefit

- Guaranteed Issue no medical qualification¹
- · Must apply before age 70
- Lifetime coverage for Life Insurance and Funeral Expense Benefit

¹ To qualify for the Life Insurance and/or Extended Health Insurance coverage on a non-medical, guaranteed issue basis, application must be submitted within 60 days of retirement, or within 60 days after the termination of coverage through another group insurance program.

Extended Health Care

- Guaranteed Issue no medical qualification¹
- No Age Limit
- · Select coverage to suit needs:

Core Health Plan may be purchased as a stand-alone plan, or add one, or a combination of, 3 riders:

- 1. Prescription Drugs, and/or
- 2. Dental, and/or
- 3. Semi-Private Hospital Room

Core Health Plan includes coverage for ambulance, accidental dental, hearing aids, glasses, home nursing, paramedical services; medical appliances and equipment.

Emergency Medical Travel Insurance

- No Age Limit
- Out of Province /Out of Country
- Up to \$5 Million Canadian of coverage
- Up to 182 days (212 for Ontario residents) outside your province, territory of residence or Canada
- For applicants aged 55 and up, medical evidence is required, and rates determined based on age, medical history and trip duration
- Application for the Emergency Medical Travel Insurance may be made at any time
